A CLASSIC NEW YEARS MELODY
It's a New Years tradition to sing "Auld Lang Syne," a Scottish poem that was recorded on paper officially in 1788 by the Scottish poet Robert Burns, according to Scotland.org. The melody itself, however, is a much older folk song that was known in Scotland, and the Scottish Museum set Burns' words to the tune when he sent it in, according to the English Folk Dance and Song Society.

"There is an old song and tune which has often thrilled through my soul," Burns said in reference to the popular melody in his 1788 letter, according to the Burns encyclopedia.


In English, the literal translation of Auld Lang Syne is "old long times," but it means something more along the lines of "once upon a time." With its touch of nostalgia, it soon became a mainstay at British and Scottish funerals, farewells and group celebrations. It didn't make it across the pond as a New Year's tradition until 1929, however, when the Guy Lombardo orchestra played it at a hotel in New York.

Lincoln Hospital and Clinics is proud to present their newly re-designed website at www.lincolnhospital.org.

The new site features information about the public hospital district, details for patients and visitors, the services provided, and more. New and improved features include:

- Access for patients to MyChart, a free service that gives patients secure, online access to their health care team and medical record at the Reardan Clinic, Davenport Clinic or Wilbur Clinic, along with any Providence Health & Services location. With MyChart, patients can review their medications, immunizations and medical history, communicate with their health care team, request prescription renewals, review results for most tests, and get clinic after-visit summaries. Patients can request access to MyChart through the new site.

- A provider directory that allows patients to search for a specific provider or to see which providers specialize in the patient's specific health care need.

- Health resources including a health library with recipes, infographics, articles, and health tools. There are also free health e-newsletters that can be subscribed to by email on the site. Subscribers decide how often they want to receive the newsletters, that include timely health information and Lincoln Hospital and Clinics news and service features.

- The ability to send free Cheer Cards to loved ones staying at Lincoln Hospital through the site. Senders have various designs and occasions to choose from and the cards will be hand-delivered to patients by Lincoln Hospital staff within 48 hours of being ordered online. This allows friends and family to connect with loved ones even if they aren't able to visit them.

- Job-seekers can now submit an online job application through the site in the Careers section, which is frequently updated with new job postings for all of the Lincoln Hospital and Clinics locations.

Pay by Credit Card Option Now Available for Lake Roosevelt National Recreation Area Campsite Fees and Boat Launch Permits

Thinking about winter camping or boating at Lake Roosevelt? You now have the option to pay by credit card through your smart phone at all National Park Service operated campgrounds and boat launches at Lake Roosevelt National Recreation Area. Each pay station contains a QR code and instructions to help guide you to pay.gov where you can use your credit card to pay for weekly and annual boat launch permits and campsite fees.

Weekly and annual boat launch permits can be purchased before you arrive but campsite fees must be purchased once you have arrived. Please keep in mind that weekly boat launch permits are good for seven consecutive days including date of purchase and annual boat launch permits are good from date of purchase until December 31st of the year printed on the pass.

As we move into the summer season, you will still be able to either reserve a campsite through Recreation.gov or pay for a first-come, first served site through pay.gov with your credit card and smart phone. -NPS-
