CENSUS 2020: Between March 12 and 20, households will begin receiving official Census Bureau mail with detailed information on how to respond to the 2020 Census online, by phone, or by mail. When you respond to the census, you'll tell the Census Bureau where you live as of April

Why is the 2020 Census important? An accurate census will drive decisions that will affect economic investments in communities in Washington and the weight of its political influence until 2031. For every 100 households missed in the 2020 Census count, the state could lose up to \$5.8 million, which would affect the ability to support children, veterans, senior citizens and middle- and low-income families adequately. An accurate count of Washington's communities will ensure the fair distribution of taxpayers' funds and political representation.

The Constitution mandates a decennial census. Article I, Section 2 of the U.S. constitution establishes the basis for a complete population count every 10 years in order to determine the number of Congressional representatives that each state gets. The 14th Amendment makes clear that the count must include "the whole number of persons in each state."

Census data is used for political and administrative representation. Washington state uses the data to draw boundaries for every level of government down to the school districts. Due to growth in the state between 2000 and 2010, Washington was also able to send an additional representative to Congress. While the state is unlikely to gain another seat in the 2020 Census, an accurate count is important to ensuring fair and equal representation at all levels.

Federal, state, and local government agencies rely on census data for planning and delivering education, economic development and employment, health, and transportation services. In FY2016, Washington state received \$16.7 billion from 55 federal programs based on census data. It is estimated that 300 federal programs allocate funds based on census-derived statistics.

But, it is not just governments that use census data to plan, budget, and make policy. Businesses use the census to decide where to build factories, offices and stores, which creates jobs. Developers use the census to build new homes and revitalize old neighborhoods. Local governments use the census for public safety and emergency preparedness. Transportation planners use the census to decide on public transit routes. Citizen or-

ganizations rely on census data to identify community needs, request and fund programs, monitor trends and assess program effectiveness. Residents use the census to support community initiatives involving quality-of-life legislation, and consumer advocacy.



Apricity: The warmth of the sun in winter **Barchan:** A horseshoe-shaped snowdrift

Cornice: An overhanging accumulation of ice and wind-

blown snow

Dendrite: A type of snowflake that has six points. The ar-

chetypal "snowflake" shape

Finger drift: A narrow snowdrift across a roadway.

Firn: Snow that is more than a year old, but that has not yet consolidated into ice.

Flurry: A brief snowfall that produces little accumulation **Freshet:** The occurrence of a water flow resulting from

sudden rain or melting snow

Graupel: Granular snow pellets, also called soft hail

Grue: Thin floating ice or snow

Hogamadog: An old English word for a large ball of snow made by rolling a smaller snowball through a snowfield **Needle:** A snowflake that is much longer than it is wide

Onding: A heavy fall of rain or snow

Penitents: Tall, thin, spikes of hardened snow

Polycrystal: A formation made up of several snowflakes

that fuse into one massive flake

Powder: New snow composed of loose, fresh crystals **Roller:** A naturally occurring cylinder of snow formed by

the wind

Sastrugi: Irregular grooves and ridges in snow caused by wind **Sitzmark:** A depression left in the snow by a skier falling

backward

Skift: a light fall of snow or rain Sleet: frozen or partly frozen rain Snirt: Snow mixed with dirt Sposh: soft slushy mud or snow

Whiteout: a blizzard that reduces visibility to near zero
