

SBAAND TREASURY ANNOUNCE PPP RE-OPENING; ISSUE NEW GUIDANCE

The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA), in consultation with the Treasury Department, announced today that the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) will re-open the week of January 11 for new borrowers and certain existing PPP borrowers. To promote access to capital, initially only community financial institutions will be able to make First Draw PPP Loans on Monday, January 11, and Second Draw PPP Loans on Wednesday, January 13. The PPP will open to all participating lenders shortly thereafter. Updated PPP guidance outlining Program changes to enhance its effectiveness and accessibility was released on January 6 in accordance with the Economic Aid to Hard-Hit Small Businesses, Non-Profits, and Venues Act.

This round of the PPP continues to prioritize millions of Americans employed by small businesses by authorizing up to \$284 billion toward job retention and certain other expenses through March 31, 2021, and by allowing certain existing PPP borrowers to apply for a Second Draw PPP Loan.

"The historically successful Paycheck Protection Program served as an economic lifeline to millions of small businesses and their employees when they needed it most," said Administrator Jovita Carranza. "Today's guidance builds on the success of the program and adapts to the changing needs of small business owners by providing targeted relief and a simpler forgiveness process to ensure their path to recovery."

"The Paycheck Protection Program has successfully provided 5.2 million loans worth \$525 billion to America's small businesses, supporting more than 51 million jobs," said Treasury Secretary Steven T. Mnuchin. "This updated guidance enhances the PPP's targeted relief to small businesses most impacted by COVID-19. We are committed to implementing this round of PPP quickly to continue supporting American small businesses and their workers." Key PPP updates include:

·PPP borrowers can set their PPP loan's covered period to be any length between 8 and 24 weeks to best meet their business needs

· PPP loans will cover additional expenses, including operations expenditures, property damage costs, supplier costs, and worker protection expenditures;

- The Program's eligibility is expanded to include 501(c)(6)s, housing cooperatives, direct marketing organizations, among other types of organizations;
- · The PPP provides greater flexibility for seasonal employees;

· Certain existing PPP borrowers can request to modify their First Draw PPP Loan amount

· Certain existing PPP borrowers are now eligible to apply for a Second Draw PPP Loan.

A borrower is generally eligible for a Second Draw PPP Loan if the borrower:

· Previously received a First Draw PPP Loan and will or has used the full amount only for authorized uses · Has no more than 300 em-

ployees

· Can demonstrate at least a 25% reduction in gross receipts between comparable guarters in 2019 and 2020. The new guidance released includes:

· PPP Guidance from SBA Administrator Carranza on Accessing Capital for Minority, Underserved, Veteran, and Women-owned Business Concerns;

·Interim Final Rule on Paycheck Protection Program as Amended by Economic Aid Act; and

·Interim Final Rule on Second Draw PPP Loans.

EDC OVERSEES \$700,000 IN RELIEF FUNDS IN 2020 Margie Hall

The Lincoln County Economic Development Council has closed the books on 2020, ending a year that did not go as planned. Due to the pandemic, the EDC set aside previously scheduled projects and focused their attention on obtaining and utilizing Coronavirus Relief Funds. Since Governor Inslee's "Stay Home, Stay Healthy" order took effect in March, the EDC has facilitated over \$700,000 in grant awards.

The federal CARES Act provided for Coronavirus Relief Fund payments to state and local governments to combat the effects of the COVID-19 outbreak. The EDC helped the State Department of Commerce administer two state-funded small business grant programs that resulted in nearly \$300,000 going to Lincoln County businesses. The EDC also facilitated three grant programs for Lincoln County Commissioners, who allocated \$261,000 of the county's Coronavirus Relief Funds (CRF) for local business support. Additionally, Almira, Harrington, Odessa and Sprague partnered with the EDC to distribute a combined \$56,000 in CRF grants to their local businesses. Grants from the Innovia Foundation and the Tri County Economic Development District brought another \$30,000 in small business funding to Lincoln County bringing the total in grants to \$647,000.


Lincoln County Commissioners also allotted \$65,000 to Lincoln County's food banks and other

eligible nonprofits.

The small business assistance grants were focused on reimbursement of operating costs incurred while businesses were negatively affected by the pandemic or the state's response to the pandemic, filling a gap that unemployment insurance and the Payroll Protection Program did not cover. The nonprofit grants went to organizations to help with utilities and other costs associated with facility support and maintenance. Lincoln County Chambers of Commerce also received small grants to replace revenue lost due to fundraising event cancellations.

Going into 2021, the EDC will continue to monitor pandemic recovery resources to keep local businesses informed.
