

LOCAL CLINICS MOVE VACCINATIONS INTO SECOND PHASE, QUANTITY LIMITED

Governor Jay Inslee and the Washington State Department of Health (DOH) announced Tuesday the move into Phase 1 Tier B1 for COVID-19 vaccinations. The phase includes individuals age 65 and over and those over 50 who live in a multigenerational household. Because of the expansion, Lincoln Hospital and Clinics is now providing COVID-19 vaccinations to this group of people as the vaccine supply is available.

"We would love to vaccinate everyone who wants it, but we have to have the vaccine to do it and we have to follow the state's distribution plan," said Katie Schenk, Clinics Manager for Lincoln Hospital and Clinics. The clinics have been inundated with phone calls from people interested in receiving the vaccine. "We are working diligently to be good stewards of our minimal supply to ensure those in our communities who meet the current criteria and are higher risk have an opportunity to be vaccinated."

Currently, the clinics plan to have 100 doses available to them that will be distributed at a scheduled vaccine clinic today (Thursday) with a booster clinic scheduled in February. It is unknown how many doses will be later allocated by the state, or if vaccines will arrive on a regular basis. More vaccine is being actively sought out by the hospital district and will be immediately distributed to the community based on the appropriate phase distribution criteria.

Vaccines are still available to individuals in Phase 1, Tier A1 and A2 and this group is placed as a priority. These include health care employees, first responders, and staff and residents of long-term care facilities.

The clinics are scheduling vaccinations based on a waiting list of qualified patients and encourage anyone who would like to be on the list to contact them - even if they aren't eligible for vaccination until a later phase. "We'll ask you questions to assess your eligibility and placement on the waiting list and we ask for patience in the process. This helps us determine the need and plan for distribution," Schenk said.

CAMPING FEE INCREASE

AT LAKE ROOSEVELT NATIONAL RECREATION AREA

Beginning at 12:01 am on January 29, 2021 individual campsite fees will increase at Lake Roosevelt National Recreation Area. Annually, campsite fees depend on the time of year you are camping. From May 1 through September 30 campsite fees will increase from \$18 per night to \$23 per night. From October 1 through April 30 campsite fees will increase from \$9 per night to \$11.50 per night. This fee increase will allow the National Park Service to stay in-line with local market pricing for similar campgrounds.

At this time, camping at Lake Roosevelt is limited to Kettle Falls loop 1, Fort Spokane loop 1, and Spring Canyon loop 1. Reservations are now required all year but can be made in advance or from the campground upon arrival with adequate cell phone service. Reservations must be made at recreation gov or by calling 877-444-6777.

While these areas are accessible for visitors to enjoy, a return to full operations will continue to be phased in in alignment with the most current Washington State phased opening plan. We will continue to monitor all park functions to adhere to CDC guidance

for mitigating risks associated with the transmission of COVID-19 and take any additional steps necessary to protect public and staff health. As the park is able to open additional campgrounds, the new campsite prices will apply, and the campsites will be added to the reservation system at recreation.gov.

When recreating, the public should follow state health orders, practice Leave No Trace principles, avoid crowding and avoid highrisk outdoor activities. The CDC has offered guidance to help people recreating in parks and open spaces to prevent the spread of infectious diseases.






