





DR. PAUL GROVE: A REVIEW by Jeri' Kanally




As a relatively new resident of Harrington WA (March 2022). I'm so delighted and grateful for the incredibly talented performers offered by the beautiful and nostalgic Harrington Opera House. Dr. Paul Grove's solo guitar performance of music from around the world, was quite exceptional! He's been a featured soloist with the NW region's most prominent symphonies and ensembles. He has toured throughout the US, as well as in Russia, Brazil, India, and Canada. Having such a world renowned, talented performer, come to our little town and per-

form in our opera house, was so special for us. He came to Harrington knowing his audience would be small. It seems to me like a sort of music mission trip, away from the big city to our quaint little farm town. It must be for the pure pleasure of sharing his musical gifts with us. We are honored and so very grateful. When I was thanking Dr. Grove after the show, I told him I was thankful enough for a hundred more people! My hope is that our Opera House audience will grow and support more amazing talent.

During Dr. Grove's performance, he enlightened and entertained us by sharing historical information on his selections from around the world and why he chose them. Through his stories, we could see and sense his heartfelt love for each piece of music. But then, when he played his guitar, the music was so thought provoking, emotive and pictorial. We could envision all the different cultures, their people in love, in sadness, in hope, in fear, and in joy. What a delight it was to hear him play a piece called, "Green Fields And Meadows," composed by George Frederick McKay, Harrington WA (1899-1970). The lighthearted and romantic flow in Mr. McKay's music made it so easy to envision the same lush green farm lands and beautiful meadows surrounding Harrington. How special!

Dr. Grove told us a tragic and triumphant story about an amazing connection he has with an Afghan composer and children's music teacher, Ustad Sarmast. The composer

feared for his family's life when escaping the Afghanistan war, and continued to risk his life because he would not stop composing, playing and teaching music. When Dr. Grove played the Afghan composer's piece titled, "Farwardin," it made my heart and eyes well up. Even though the tune was light and beautiful, it had an undertone, a low note of sadness. I was suddenly surprised when I briefly envisioned a terrified Afghanistan woman running away, looking back in fear. Wow. Is it possible that my vision was a sight the composer had seen? Can music do that...travel all the way from an Afghan composer's life to my life in this little town? Perhaps. Music is an incredibly far reaching gift! The world hears laughing and crying in the same language. Music must have the power and potential for a vastly bigger conversation, a way of communicating an understanding and connecting us all in very unique ways. When Dr. Grove was all finished playing, he stood smiling and thanked us. But then, in an almost sad and serious tone, he said, "The world needs more music." DAVENPORT FFA BRINGS BACK SILVER FROM NATIONALS

At a bright and early 4:00 a.m. on Friday, October 27th the Davenport FFA began a journey that started 84 years earlier in 1939... a trip to compete for the first time ever at the National FFA Convention

in Indianapolis, Indiana. Our Nursery Landscape team finished as State Champions back in May and finally got to represent Washington in the national contest. We were one of 43 states to compete and finished with a Silver Emblem placing, which put us into the top third of teams competing, and is very commendable in such a challenging contest. The students worked extremely hard to make this trip a possibility and were rewarded with some amazing experiences.

The first leg of our trip took us to Nashville, Tennessee where the students got to see Carrie Underwood perform at the world famous Grand Ole Opry; visited the home, tomb and plantation of our nation's 7th President, Andrew Jackson; the tomb of our 11th President James K. Polk; and spent some time along the country music mecca of Broadway Avenue in downtown. While in Tennessee we also took the opportunity to visit a Civil War battlefield in the town of Franklin. At the Carnton home in Franklin, we were treated to an impromptu lesson from a local historian, which was an absolute treat. We were able to learn first hand about the Civil War, and even explored a Confederate cemetery, certainly something we would never be able to do in the Northwest.

The next leg of our journey led us to the Louisville Slugger Museum and Factory in Louisville, Kentucky. At the museum, students were able to see some amazing exhibits of Major League Baseball history including being able to hold game used bats owned by some of baseball's greatest players: Babe Ruth, Hank Aaron, Ken Griffey Jr., Daryl Strawberry, Willie Mays, Derek Jeter and more. During the factory tour they learned about everything from the agricultural products used to the process of bat making: every step was covered from tree in the forest to bat in the hand. The tour included a lesson on the different wood densities and how they perform as baseball bats. Each student was given a mini bat souvenir as we left. From Louisville we headed to Indianapolis for the convention.

The day before the convention started, we studied at a local nursery before heading to our last sight seeing tour at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway, or the Brickyard for those racing enthusiasts. During the tour, students got to ride a lap around the course and stopped to kiss the bricks at the finish line. Unfortunately, there were no bottles of milk available to chug, but an incredible experience nonetheless. Our last historical stop was to visit the home and grave of the 23rd President of the United States, Benjamin Harrison. We learned that President Harrison was actually historically significant to Washingtonians as he was the President who admitted Washington State into the Union in 1889.

That is all before the convention started. This year the National FFA announced that nearly 70,000 members are in Indianapolis for this year's convention. To give a sense of what that is like, if you've ever participated in Bloomsday, imagine that, double it, and everyone is wearing FFA blue courdoroy jackets. It was an absolute sea of FFA members clogging the roads between the football stadium and convention center in Indianapolis. During the National FFA Convention, students competed on day one and spent the rest of their time attending workshops, listening to guest speakers, completing convention tasks, meeting members from all over the U.S. and experiencing the largest college fair and ag expo in the country. This trip was an eye opening experience for everyone and could not have happened without the support of parents, teachers and the Davenport community. Thank you to everyone for all of your support!




