"We would hate for our patients to sign up for this plan, only to find out they aren't covered when they need to access healthcare with us and many of the other providers in our area," said Timothy O'Connell, Chief Financial Officer for Lincoln Hospital and Clinics.

Lincoln Hospital and Clinics has opted not to work with United Healthcare in this new exchange platform offering due to ongoing issues for patients and providers with coverage and payment. "Our experience is that this company has made it difficult for our patients to access healthcare," O'Connell said.

All other insurance products offered for Lincoln County on the state's health insurance exchange are accepted at Lincoln Hospital and Clinics. Those shopping health insurance for should always check to make sure a potentially new insurance product is accepted with their primary care providers and the healthcare systems they primarily utilize. This can be done by calling the healthcare provider's billing office or entering that information on the HealthPlanFinder website when shopping for a plan at www.wahealthplanfinder.org.

PUBLIC HEALTH ENCOURAGES RESIDENTS TO TAKE PRECAUTIONS, FOLLOW RESTRICTIONS

Washington state has seen an increase in COVID cases that led to a four-week statewide set of restrictions announced by Governor Jay Inslee earlier this week. The Governor's orders include restrictions on dining-in, retail customer capacity, and gatherings.

The average number of cases for the state doubled over the past two weeks with the numbers in Lincoln County following the trend. As of Tuesday, November 17, Lincoln County had 39 new cases in 14 days, which put the case rate at 365 cases per 100,000 people. There have been a total of 123 confirmed positive cases in the county with 2 deaths.

Recently, outbreaks have occurred in the county associated with Vista Manor, a local assisted living facility, as well as Odessa Memorial Hospital's swing bed unit. Some schools have also been impacted by community acquired cases that resulted in students and staff being quarantined. The Lincoln County Health Department is working closely with all these facilities to address the outbreaks and provide them with necessary support. Contact tracing has occurred for each positive case and those who have been exposed are notified.

"November has already become our highest case count month since the pandemic began," said Ed Dzedzy, public health administrator for Lincoln County. "I know everyone is tired of taking precautions, but it's vital that we be diligent about masking, washing our hands, staying home when you're sick, and social distancing at the very least to mitigate spread."

Like in the spring when the pandemic began, there is again concern with overrunning the local healthcare systems with COVID patients. Also, access to protective equipment for healthcare workers remains a consistent issue – one that is compounded by increased hospitalizations. Spokane hospitals held a conference call last week to work together to plan for medical surge in response to the recent increased hospitalizations.

"There's no need for panic," Dzedzy said. "We just need to step back for a moment to protect each other and allow the spread to slow down."
