

WARMING UP WITHOUT WORRY

As winter arrives in our communities, furnaces will fire up, thermostats will climb, and wood stoves will stay burning to keep our homes warm and cozy. There are health benefits to staying warm, but staying warm safely is more important.

Carbon monoxide (CO) is an odorless, colorless, tasteless gas that is a byproduct of burning fuels. Almost all home heating options produce carbon monoxide, except electrical heaters, though they have their own safety concerns. Whether you have a traditional furnace or a wood stove, reducing the risk of CO poisoning and knowing the signs could save a life.

Symptoms of CO poisoning are similar to the flu, but can come on within 30 minutes, CO has collected in the room.

depending on how much Symptoms to watch for include headache, fatigue, shortness of breath, nausea/vomiting, dizziness, and confusion. CO can collect in unusual ways, depending on the air flow: it is common for one room to have dangerous CO levels while the rest of the home

is safe. Pets, especially



birds, are often affected by it before we are, as their smaller lung capacity and unique systems are affected faster.

Good news: CO poisoning is completely preventable! Installing CO detectors is an easy way to ensure there is no build up without a warning, and some smoke detectors now include CO monitors. CO detectors are relatively inexpensive: there are lots of options for under \$20. If you rent, landlords in Washington state are required to provide CO monitors. Make sure to find one with UL on it,

as they set the standard in electrical safety, and check the battery at least twice a year. Remember, if the alarm sounds, leave your home immediately and call your local fire department.

Keeping up with the service of your furnace/heating unit and remembering to clean out wood burning stoves regularly will reduce the risk. If you use a portable heater, choose the right size for the room, make sure it is vented, and only use the designated fuels for it. Never use other appliances—such as a stove—as an alternate heating source.

Our ability to fight off illnesses is affected by the especially temperature, if we're over 65, have a disability, or a long-term health condition. Staying

warm supports our immune system working at its very best, allowing us to fight off the increase of viruses that circulate this time of year. Cold air can increase blood pressure as our hearts work harder to keep our extremities (hands and feet) warm; they are also the first to get cold when our bodies need to conserve energy. Beyond the physical, staying warm has shown to have a positive effect on our mental health: the National Health Service in the UK estimating seasonal affect disorder can be reduced by half, simply by staying warm.

Staying warm will help you stay healthy this winter. Taking preventative measures to protect your home from carbon monoxide poisoning and knowing the symptoms will help you stay safe this winter. Staying happy, well that's up to you.

HAVE A HAPPY AND **HEALTHY HOLIDAY**

The countdown to the holidays has already begun with some celebrations the first full week of December. We all want to keep our families and loved ones safe and be able to enjoy the holidays by gathering together. As you go down your to-do list to get

ready, make sure getting up-to-date with your vaccines is on it. This includes the flu, COVID, and pneumonia, depending on your age. Remember, vaccines should be given at least two weeks before any gatherings to allow for the best protection.

This year, the flu shot was created to protect against four different variations of the flu. Each year the vaccines are updated to account for the previous year's versions and provide the best protection against what's expected this year. Flu shots are recommended for everyone six months or older, with special versions available for those over 65. While they can't guarantee you won't get the flu, as there are more than four versions out there, the vaccine does significantly reduce the severity: in the 2019-2020 flu season, the CDC noted vaccines were shown to reduce the need to see a doctor up to 60% of the time.

Flu shots are available at all Lincoln County clinics by appointment, with Odessa Rural Health Clinic hosting walk-in hours Monday through Thursday, 8 am to 6:30 pm. Limited flu shots are available at the Davenport Pharmacy.

The 2023-24 COVID vaccine was released in October of this year and is also recommended for everyone six months and older. Unvaccinated children under five will need two doses, with everyone else only needing one. The COVID vaccine is a completely separate vaccine from the flu vaccine. If time is a concern, you can receive both vaccines at the same time but in different arms.

COVID vaccines are available at the Reardan and Davenport Clinics, the Davenport Pharmacy, and at the Odessa walk-in clinic.

A pneumonia vaccine is recommended regularly for people 65 and older, as well as young children and people with certain health conditions. The vaccine should only be taken when you are feeling healthy. As this vaccine has some surrounding conditions that may or may not apply to you, talk with your provider or with the provider at the clinic to determine if this vaccine is one you need.

Pneumonia vaccines are available at both the Davenport and Odessa Clinics. Pneumonia vaccines require an appointment.

Your provider can help you determine which vaccines are best for your health history. Remember, being vaccinated


