You stole by brother, my other half. Stole my joyful days and restful nights.

Grandma says that if you will steal an animal, you'll steal a child. How can you keep him when his heart is breaking too? If you care anything at all about him, bring him home. PLEASE.



Born November 24, 1937, left this world and entered the arms of her Savior, August 21, 2023. Peggy was born in Chicago, Illinois to Rudolf Adolf and Marie Brusig, the middle of three daughters. The family came west in 1947 and settled on 35 acres in Prosser, Washington. She graduated from Posser High School in 1955 and attended Seattle Pacific College, now University. She returned home and found work as a laboratory technician at Hanford.

While working at Hanford, she met a dashing young soldier, James "Jim" Patrick and the couple married in July 19, 1958. James had two children from a previous marriage, Jimmy Lynn "Susie" (deceased 1965) and Ronnie, and though these children never came West to live, the families kept contact and saw each other on trips to Kentucky.
