LARGE SCALE DRUG OPERATION SEARCH WARRANTS NETS LARGE QUANTITY OF NARCOTICS AND CASH:

On 01-22-20 the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office assisted the Spokane Police Department Special Investigation Unit (SIU), U.S. Border Patrol K-9, Adams County Patrol K-9, Spokane Police Department Targeted Crimes Unit, Police Anti-Crime (PACT) and SPD SWAT serve a search warrant at a residence in Davenport, WA.

This case culminated from a lengthy investigation by detectives who developed probable cause to execute two search warrants, one in Davenport and one in a rural part of Spokane County Sheriff Wade Magers reports.

Lincoln County Undersheriff Kelly Watkins, Sergeant Mike Stauffer and Deputy Jerad McLagan executed the search warrant in Davenport, which netted approximately \$150,000 in cash. In addition some of the money was identified by SIU from previous controlled narcotics purchases co-mingled with it. In the second search warrant, which was executed in rural Spokane County, police recovered multiple pounds of illegal drugs. This included 13 pounds of Methamphetamine, 4 pounds of Heroin, 2 ounces of suspected Fentanyl and 6 firearms one of which was reported stolen. The illegal narcotics had a street value worth several hundred thousand dollars.

Sheriff Wade Magers was pleased with the partnership and teamwork with our Federal and State agencies in this effort to get such a large quantity of these harmful substances, firearms and dangerous suspects off our streets. The search warrant in Davenport resulted in the arrest of an individual that was involved in the large scale drug operation that appears to involve several jurisdictions across the state Sheriff Magers reports. Because of the sensitivity of the investigation and multiple jurisdictions involved the investigation was kept confidential and no information was released until now.

The case is currently being prosecuted in Federal Court by the U.S. Attorney's Office and members of the DEA Task Force. These types of large scale investigations often involve multiple agencies, coordination, confidentiality as well as a high level of expertise. The search warrants were considered very high risk and had the potential of extreme danger Sheriff Magers reported. The cash seized in the execution of the first search warrant was so substantial that a money counting machine had to be used to confirm the hand count of the total cash involved in the case.

The Lincoln County search warrant was served in Davenport at 306 14th Street and suspect Emilia Perez was arrested at the scene without further incident.

COVID-19 UPDATE: Lincoln Hospital and Clinics want to ensure our patients and communities stay informed about Novel Coronavirus. We are taking interim infection prevention measures in all our locations to address COVID-19 and contain the potential for spread.

What you need to know

Most COVID-19 cases will not need hospitalization or even treatment from a healthcare professional. If you are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, **please call your primary care provider before going to a clinic or ER** or call the DOH Coronavirus Hotline at 1-800-525-0127, press # for symptom evaluation. If you feel you need to be seen, please call us at 509-725-7101 prior to arriving at our emergency room. You will be asked to wear a mask prior to entering the facility. Masks will be available at our main entrance.

The most common symptoms of COVID-19 are fever, trouble breathing, and dry cough. Some patients may have aches and pains, nasal congestion, runny nose, sore throat or diarrhea. These symptoms are usually mild and begin gradually. Some people become infected but don't develop any symptoms and don't feel unwell. Most people (about 80%) recover from the disease without needing special treatment. Around 1 out of every 6 people who gets COVID-19 becomes seriously ill and develops difficulty breathing. Older people, and those with underlying medical problems like high blood pressure, heart problems or diabetes, are more likely to develop serious illness. Call your doctor if you develop symptoms, and have been in close contact with a person known to have COVID-19 or have recently traveled from an area with widespread or ongoing spread of COVID-19 and you have developed symptoms.

There will be only one entrance (the main entrance) open to the public for admission to the hospital. This means patients going to our surgical clinic or physical therapy will need to enter through the main entrance as well.

Visitor restrictions have been implemented for all patients at Lincoln Hospital. Visitors must be screened at the main entrance by having their temperature taken and will be asked the following questions:

1. Do you have a cough?
2. Do you have shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
3. Have you come in close contact with a lab-confirmed COVID-19 patient?
4. Have you traveled from affected geographic areas?

If the visitor answers yes to any of these questions and/or they have a temperature of 100.4 or higher, they will not be permitted to enter the facility.

Visitors will also be restricted to the following:

- Temperature of 100.3* or lower (as verified at the entrance)
- Must sign in on the visitor log
- Must be immediate family to the patient. (Parents, brothers, sisters, children, or spouses. There are no exceptions to this.) Even still, we ask that family limit their visits at this time. Must be 20 years of age or older. No person ages 19 and younger will be permitted to enter the facility as a visitor.
- Visiting hours will be restricted to 8:00 am - 4:30 pm each day so visitors can be screened.

Most cases of COVID-19 will not mean hospitalization, or even a trip to an emergency room. Hospital care is a precious resource that needs to be reserved for those with the most serious symptoms. Follow the advice of public health to prevent infection, these are common sense steps like washing your hands, not touching your face, staying home when you are sick, coughing or sneezing into a tissue and throwing that tissue away.

If you are sick, stay home

and manage your symptoms as you would any cold.

If your symptoms become worse, call your primary care provider or the DOH coronavirus hotline at 1-800-525-0127, press # for symptom evaluation. Continue to see your provider for regularly scheduled visits to address your other health care needs. Do not neglect your existing needs.

In an effort to minimize spread and exposure to potential COVID-19, the Lincoln Cafe Express is closed to the public until further notice. It will be made available in a limited capacity for employees.
