every student to set up some communication with teachers. This extended school closure is an opportunity to engage in enriching, fun and engaging activities.  The school district is providing a Chromebook portable computer for each student to use during this emergency closure. Many students have already picked up their Chromebook during the designated times last week or have received their device from their bus driver during meal delivery. 


