





LAKE ROOSEVELT NATIONAL RECREATION AREA IS INCREASING RECREATIONAL ACCESS

Following guidance from the White House, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and state and local public health authorities, Lake Roosevelt National Recreation Area is increasing recreational access and services. The National Park Service (NPS) is working service-wide with federal, state, and local public health authorities to closely monitor the COVID-19 pandemic and using a phased approach to increase access on a park-by-park basis.

While the Washington State Stay at Home order has lapsed and four of the five counties (Lincoln, Stevens, Ferry, Grant, and Okanogan counties) surrounding Lake Roosevelt have entered Phase 2 of the Washington State Safe Restart plan (https://www. governor.wa.gov/news-media/inslee-issues-safe-start-proclamation-county-approachre-opening), Washington State, while modified, remains in Phase 1. At this time, the National Park Service reminds everyone that campgrounds and other facilities at Lake Roosevelt National Recreation Area will remain closed until further notice.

"Lake Roosevelt National Recreation Area is a magnet for visitors from outside the five counties that border the Lake. According to a visitor survey conducted in 2016 (https://www.nps.gov/laro/getinvolved/planning.htm), 94% of our visitors come from throughout Washington State. With an average annual visitation of 1.3 million people a year, approximately 1 million of those visitors come between April and September each year." says Dan Foster, Superintendent of Lake Roosevelt National Recreation Area. "Of those visitors, 500,000 people come from three Washington State counties: Spokane, King, and Snohomish. Opening camping encourages people from high COVID19 areas to travel to low COVID19 areas despite current Washington State guidance. We are supporting Washington State's phased opening to help protect the small communities surrounding Lake Roosevelt."

Beginning June 1st, 2020, Lake Roosevelt will begin accepting boat I aunch fee payments by credit card only:

- Weekly boat launch fees can be purchased at https://www.pay.gov/public/form/ start/656441199. These permits can be purchased before you leave home.
- Annual boat launch permits can be purchased with a credit card either online at https://www.pay.gov/public/form/start/64970644 or in person at select locations around Lake Roosevelt (https://www.nps.gov/laro/planyourvisit/fees.htm).
 If purchasing on-line, please allow a minimum of seven days to receive your permit in the mail.

Phase One also allows for the following activities at Lake Roosevelt:

- Commercial Guide services with two or fewer people from the same household.
- Marina slip rentals are open when the water rises high enough to support the operations.
- Marina houseboat and watercraft rentals to individuals of the same household. The following spaces continue to be available:
- Eight day-use areas (Spring Canyon, Keller Ferry, Fort Spokane, Porcupine Bay, Hunters, Bradbury Beach, Kettle Falls, and Evans)
- Nine boat launch docks (Spring Canyon, Keller Ferry, Seven Bays, Fort Spokane, Porcupine Bay, Hunters, Bradbury Beach, Kettle Falls, and Evans)
- Boat launches throughout the lake as the water level rises.
- Shoreline outside of the two Reservation's boundaries. You must be fully self-contained if you are planning to camp. There are no floating restrooms or backcountry facilities available. If you pack it in, pack it out. This includes human waste and waste disposal bags, disposable gloves, and masks.

With public health in mind,

the following facilities and services remain closed at this time:

• All campgrounds and vault and flush restrooms. Bring your own outdoor toilet option (marine sanitation device for your boat or something like a Luggable Loo, Wag Bags, Biffy Bags, etc. for day-use areas) soap, water, hand sanitizer and toilet paper with you.


- Water services
- Fish cleaning stations
- The Visitor Center
- All public and education programs
- Trash collection. If you pack it in, pack it out. This includes human waste and waste disposal bags, disposable gloves, and masks.

While these areas are accessible for visitors to enjoy, a return to full operations will continue to be phased and services will be limited. When recreating, the public should follow state health orders, practice Leave No Trace principles, avoid crowding and avoid high-risk outdoor activities.

The CDC has offered guidance to help people recreating in parks and open spaces prevent the spread of infectious diseases. We will continue to monitor all park functions to ensure that visitors adhere to CDC guidance for mitigating risks associated with the transmission of COVID-19 and take any additional steps necessary to protect public health. Details and updates on park operations will continue to be posted on our website www.nps.gov/laro and social media channels. Updates about NPS operations will be posted on www.nps.gov/coronavirus.

'CALL 811 BEFORE YOU DIG'

Safety is top-of-mind for all of us right now as our communities take steps to help contain the spread of Covid-19. As people are staying home for social distancing purposes, and many are turning to springtime projects in their yard we are seeing an increase of dig-in related damages at this time. For your safety, if your project requires digging or trenching, Avista Utilities is reminding you to call 811 at least two business days before digging—it's the law.

During this time of Covid-19, the 811 Call Before You Dig underground utility location services are still available. Knowing where underground utility lines are buried before you dig will help protect you—and others around you from injury, prevent damages to utilities and service disruptions.

Calling 811 will give peace of mind when stepping on the shovel or starting up the backhoe. There is no worrying about safety, extra cost or downtime- all of which can happen from digging into an underground line. Even a simple project like digging a hole for a mailbox post or planting a tree can have serious consequences if they don't call 811 first.

The depth of utility lines varies and there may be multiple utility lines in one common area, so it's important to know where all are located before digging. For more safe digging tips, see myavista.com/811 and make sure to call 811 or go online at call811.com two business days before starting any project that involves digging. Having the utility lines located is a free service for residential customers. We care about your safety. Please call 8-1-1 to have any underground utilities marked in your dig area(s).
