This includes providing activities that promote recovery, self-advocacy, development of natural supports, and maintenance of community living skills for individuals with substance use disorders; sharing one's own recovery stories that are relevant and helpful in overcoming the obstacles faced by individuals and families; and promoting client independence/ rehabilitation/recovery to prevent homelessness, crises, avoidable inpatient treatment episodes, and other negative outcomes.


