



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CRYSTAL COVE **BOAT-IN CAMPGROUND**

AT LAKE ROOSEVELT Effective immediately, and remaining until further notice, the Superintendent has closed all federal land located within the Crystal Cove boatin campground under the authority granted by 36 CFR §1.5 due to bear activity. This closure extends along the shoreline 1/4 mile in either direction from the established campground.

THE HEAT IS PRETTY "RUFF" ON PETS

According to state law (RCW 16.52.340), it is against the law for anyone to "leave or confine any animal in unattended motor vehicle or enclosed space". A person can be charged with animal cruelty in the first degree or second degree for doing so because "the animal could be harmed or killed by exposure to excessive heat, cold, lack of ventilation, or lack of necessary water." If you are caught breaking this law, your ticket penalty may be \$125

It is recommended that if you see an animal trapped in a hot car, you first try to find the owner of the car. If that is not possible, call 911. Keep in mind that in Washington state, you are not allowed to break someone else's car window. Only law enforcement is legally allowed to do that!


